Harrill (February 2, 1893 – June 4, 1972) was a male also known as Fort Fisher Hermit. He became a hermit in 1955, at the age of 62, after striking Fort Fisher on the North Carolina coast from Morganton, North Carolina. He had previously been employed in a mental hospital in Morganton after his failed marriage. Harrill settled in an abandoned bunker during World War II in a salt marsh next to the Cape Fear River in the recreation area of Fort Fisher State. Harrill fed on fishing and scavenging. It became a tourist attraction and visitors would learn about its "School of Common Sense", leaving donations in a frying pan. After living as a hermit for 17 years, he died under mysterious circumstances in 1972, with the official cause of death given as a heart attack. His life has been commemorated in books, films and theatre. Robert E. Harrill was born in Shelby, North Carolina on February 2, 1893. He was educated at Boiling Springs High School and then at Gardner-Webb Jr. College. [1] Her parents were abusive and she spent much of her time in the local woods. [2] He married Katie Hamrick in 1913 and they had five children. [1] The eldest son committed suicide and the family later collapsed in the 1930s due in part to Harrill's mental health problems. [2][1] Hermit The hermit's bunker in October 2007 The name "Fort Fisher Hermit" came from Fort Fisher and the Fort Fisher State Recreation Area, where Harrill settled. [3] He arrived in 1955, having left a mental institution in Morganton and then stumbled 260 miles (420 km) to the coast. [4] At first Harrill lived in a tent near the Confederate monument near the fort. [5] He then crashed into an abandoned World War II bunker set in a salt marsh near the Cape Fear River. He picked up the drift to furnish his humble home and managed to gather most of the food he needed from the swamp. 6 He ate fish, clams and oysters, and planted a vegetable garden to supplement his diet. [7] Harrill learned many of his survival skills from Em pie Hewett, a true hermit, who also lived in the salt pans of the Fort Fisher area. [5] Harrill loved to talk to visitors (who left donations in a frying pan) and his guestbook recorded thousands of voices. [6] The Robert Harrill attraction became the second largest tourist attraction in the state of North Carolina, following only North Carolina of the United States in terms of visitor numbers. [5] Visitors to Carolina Beach regularly took time to visit the hermit, and talked about his philosophy, which the "School of Common Sense." [2] He told his visitors that he was writing a book called A Tyrant in Every Home. [6] Next to the curious, Harrill met young people and drunken developers who wanted to Two men kidnapped him and robbed him. Once, after falling asleep on the beach, Harrill was arrested and charged with vagrancy, defending himself in court[6]. Harrill also attracted a large number of journalists to his bunker interested in writing about his lifestyle and beliefs. He explained its popularity in 1968: Everyone should be hermits for a few minutes or an hour about every 24 hours, to study, meditate and communicate with their creator...Millions of people want to do just what I'm doing, but since it's much easier to think than to do, they unconsciously elect me to represent them, that's why I'm successful...bert Harrill, New Hanover Sun[6] Harrill's grave is located at Federal Point Cemetery. The plaque reads, "It made people think". After living as a hermit for 17 years, Harrill died under mysterious circumstances on June 4, 1972.[1] The New Hanover County coroner called the cause of death a heart attack, but local rumors suggest that Harrill may have been killed after a violent attack. by a group of three men. The case was closed as a natural death.[4][8][7][7][7][7][7][7] Memorial and legacy A documentary film directed by Rob Hill and narrated by Barry Corbin was released in 2007. It was called The Fort Fisher Hermit: The Life and Death of Robert E. Harrill. Hill filmed 35 hours of material and interviewed 16 people who knew Harrill.[4] Fred Pickler knew Harrill and co-authored with Anne Russell the book Life and Times of the Fort Fisher Hermit, Through the Lens by Fred Pickler.[10] A local theatre company produced The Hermit of Fort Fisher, written by David Wright. "It is useless to say that Robert is, harrill, the hermit of fort fisher, knew these plants and seafood bloomed before moving into the bunker of World War II near fort fisher. Mr. warren said, robert e. harrill was born in shelby, northern caroline, on February 2, 1893. his mother and his two brothers died at the beginning of 1900 of typhoid fever. his father remarried and the stepmother was very rigid and rigid. his childhood was interrupted and grew up in a climate of family violence. He often sought loneliness in the woods or in the streams, rivers and nearby lakes, to find loneliness and refuge," said warren. he presented two slides, one depicting the Hermit before he arrived at fort fisher and another photo of him, a young man standing with members of his literary club. "Some say it was aweil-educated, however, there is no evidence that he attended college. He received a good basic education. She attended Boiling Springs High School. Springs.He later returned to the school, when he became Gardner-Webb Jr. College, to study ministry," Warren said. in 1913, Robert Harrill married katie hamrick. the couple had five children, four children and a daughter who died shortly after birth. his family and others thought Robert was disturbed. They thought the problem was caused by child abuse. problems caused the dissolution of the family in the 1930s. Katie brought his four sons into pennsylvania to live and robert earned himself a living by selling ninnoli and making jewelry like the identification bracelets. "It is said that he was once involuntarily admitted to a state hospital for under observation. It was there that he found a pamphlet on Dr. William marcus taylor and the taylor school of Bio-Psychology. He read the material and felt he had found answers to many of his problems. "He met Dr. Taylor when he went out of the hospital and began studying in his correspondence school for a degree in Bio-Psychology, when he was 62, he came to fort fisher and settled in the bunker of World War II that would become his home for 17 years. became one of the island's major tourist attractions as its fame grew. "He pretended he didn't like popularity and said he would become an hermit when all those people kept coming to see him. However, he painted "Fort Fisher's hermit" on a pillar at the entrance of the road to the bunker", said warren to the group. The hermit of fort fisher died, some say for natural causes, others suspect a crime. in June 1972, he was buried in a shelby cemetery and then transferred to the federal point cemetery of dow road, carolina beach. "He returned home," Warren said, ending his presentation.
