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Teaching and Assessing Critical Thinking Skills for Argument Analysis in Psychology

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Using a thinking-in-context (TIC) model, we assessed how well students learn to apply critical thinking skills, especially when such as critical thinking events that might be required to process critical thinking skills, actually occur. We compared the acquisition of critical thinking skills for analyzing psychological arguments in 3 groups of research methods students: 1) generic critical thinking skills related directly to the course and 2) other groups using a generic critical thinking skills assessment. We found that the group receiving explicit instruction in thinking skills assessment demonstrated greater gains in critical argumentation skills than the groups receiving no explicit critical thinking instruction. These results support the efficacy of explicitly teaching critical thinking skills related directly to explicit course instruction.

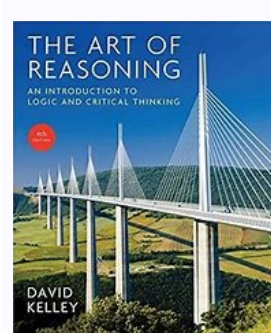
Because we teaching critical thinking (CT) has gained traction, but the empirical research underpinning it whether psychology courses are effective in teaching specific CT skills. Accordingly, we investigated the overall impact of taking psychology and other courses across an acquisition of CT skills, and we compared the acquisition of CT skills across generic psychology courses in which students either received or did not receive explicit CT skill instruction in separate studies.

We defined critical thinking, or reflective thinking, as the evaluation of evidence relevant to a claim so that a sound conclusion can be drawn from the evidence (Bensley, 2009). CT requires both skills in using rules and norms for making reasoned judgments

(Bensley, 2009) and the deployment of one those skills (Bensley, 2009). We investigated acquisition of specific critical thinking skills across two examples of CT skills (e.g., Cross, 1997; Bensley, 2009).

Because education and CT are commonly linked (Bensley & Allman, 2007), but few studies have investigated whether taking more courses creates positive CT, if acquisition of CT skills is considered discipline-specific (Bensley & Benbardi, 2005), then critical thinking psychology courses might be particularly conducive to acquisition of psychology CT skills. Psychology CT skills are associated with systematic analysis, methodological approaches to CT (Bensley, 2009, 2014, 2009). Common psychology courses include research methods (RM) courses, might be expected to be especially effective in generating psychological CT skills (O'Connell & Thompson, 2001; Spillman, Finkbeiner, and Clark, 2007) based on empirical research upon writing such as how does research RM courses, require argument analysis skills, and writing to communicate thought to process CT (Korbin, 1999). 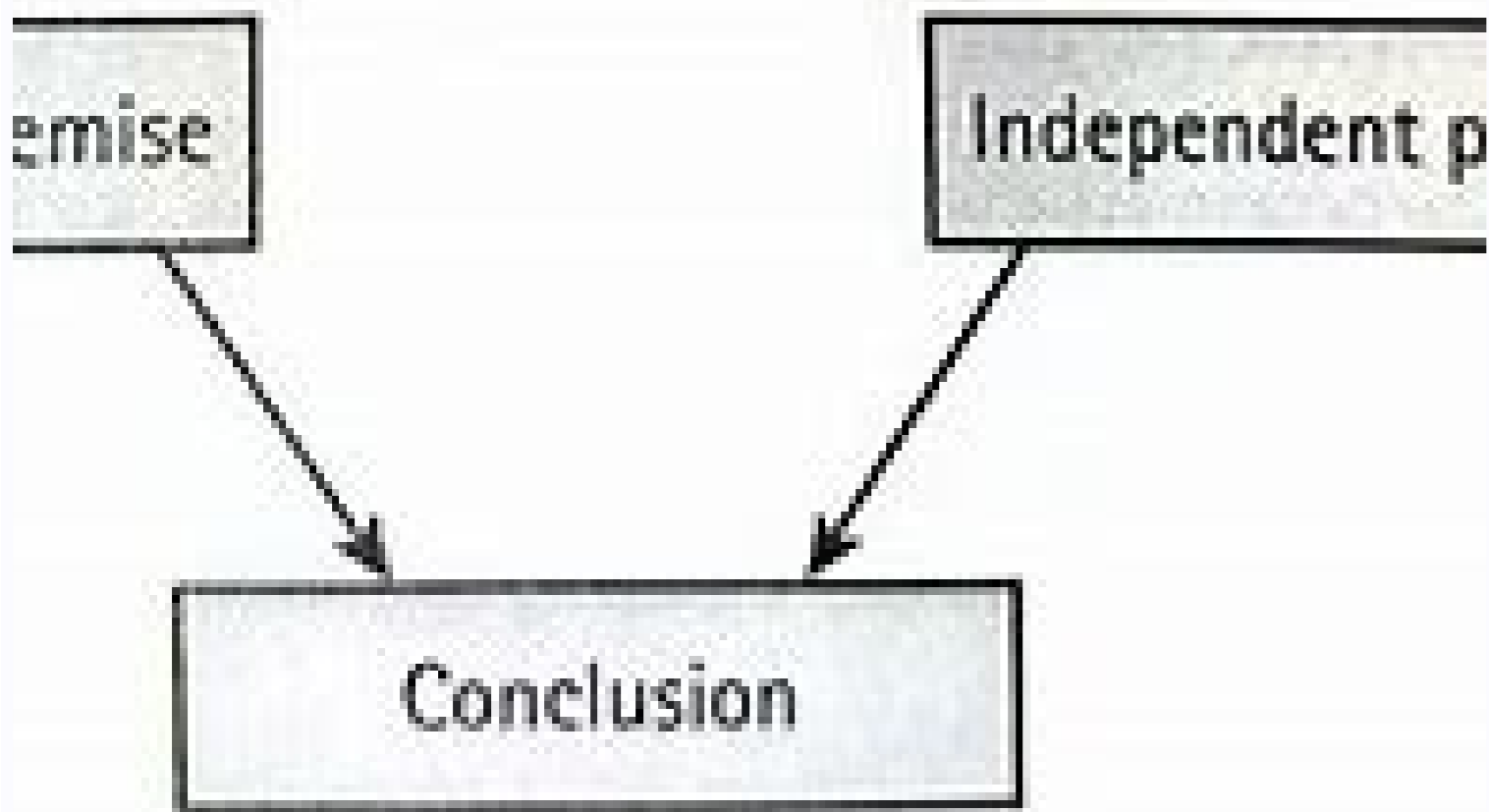
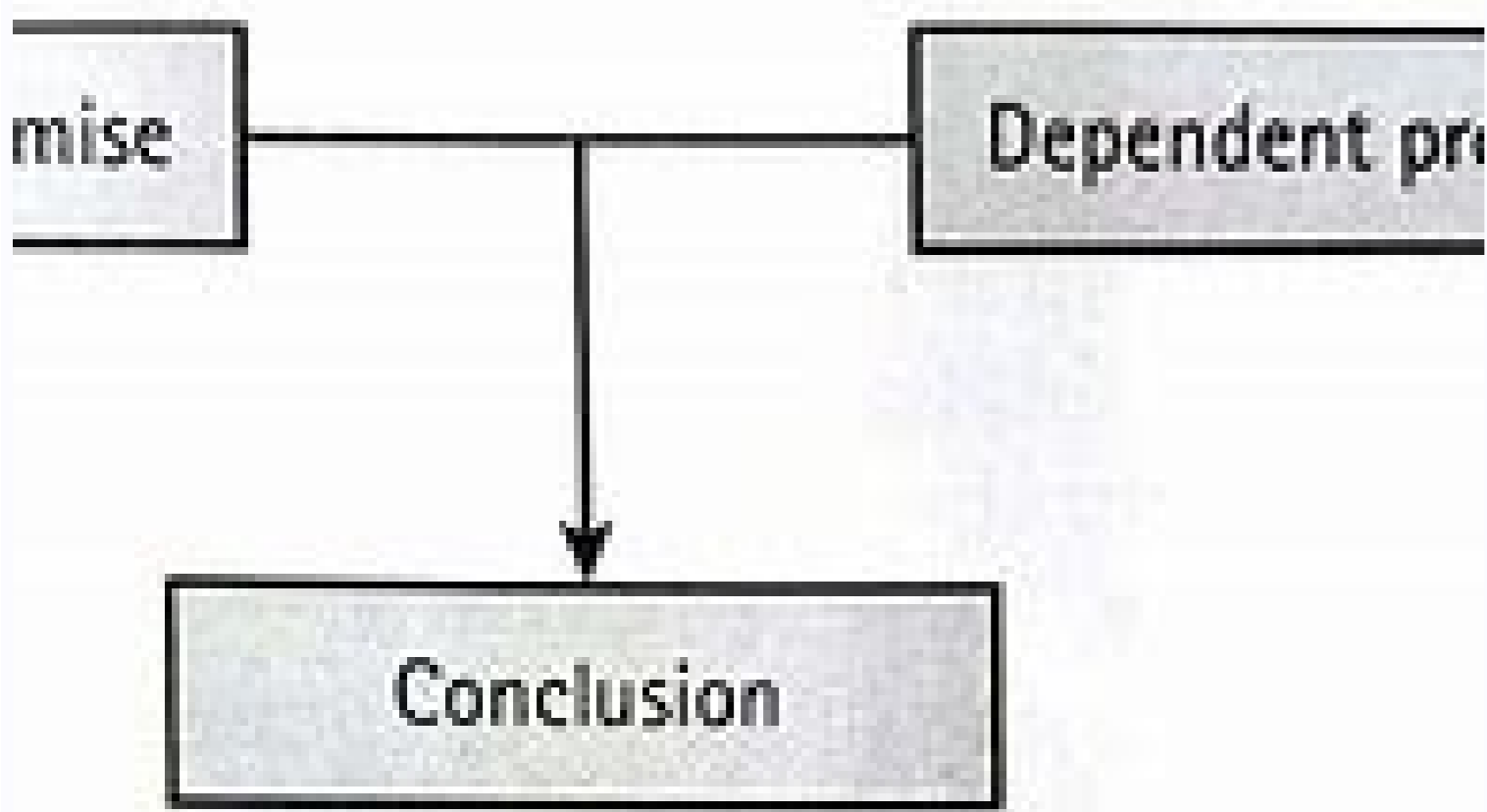
